Bikesafe Course

The Lincolnshire Police Road Safety Partnership have kindly put together a specific course purely for members of Rutland HOG and incorporated additional aspects not normally included as part of the standard course.

The day will start with a short ride, followed by a classroom session. A second longer ride will take place with police riders assessing each individual skills and areas that could be improved.

This will be on a one to one basis – one police rider to each participant. That usually ends the day, but for us, convoy riding and slow speed skills will be added. Slow speed will be demonstrated with the opportunity to try your luck!! There is a cost of £65 to join the course, with all other overheads covered by the Road Safety Partnership. There are up to 20 places available.
